Whether your choice is led by design or performance, there are several important factors to consider when choosing your wood heater:

Coverage	The size of the area the heater will warm

Burn Time	How long the heater will take to burn one load of logs on low
Efficiency	How effectively the heater burns the wood
Emissions	The volume of waste emitted from the heater

Construction	The thickness of the firebox





Installation

There are several important factors to consider when you're planning to install a wood heater:

- Heater installation dimensions
- Hearth clearances
- The position of the heater
- The installation of the flue system, and where the flue will exit the roof, as it must be sealed

It's important to use a qualified professional for installation as they can offer valuable

advice and insights as well as identify any potential problems.





Flue Installation

Below are the most common types of heater and flue installations.



Correct flue height


Most wood heater installations are completed trouble free.

But with some houses, simple extra measures need to be taken to ensure the flue is the correct height to avoid the hassle of downdrafts or smoke blowing into neighbouring properties.


The minimum height for a wood heater installation is 4.6 metres from the bottom of the heater to the top of the flue.


Sometimes the flue will need to be extended because the flue must extend a minimum of one metre from where it exits the roof.

Keep in mind that all wood heater installations must meet the latest version of the Australian installation standards, AS/NZS 2918.
